



**DESIGN OF NEW ART CENTER:** A drawing of the Gallery of Modern Art is superimposed on a photo of Columbus Circle, looking to the south. The ten-story building, commissioned by Huntington Hartford, was designed by Edward D. Stone. It will have a sheath of white marble, with window perforations, and larger openings near the top. Occupying the irregularly shaped block between Columbus Circle and 58th Street, and Broadway and Eighth Avenue, it will stand alone. A five-story building on the site is to be razed. Work on the gallery is to start late in summer. It is to open next year.
