

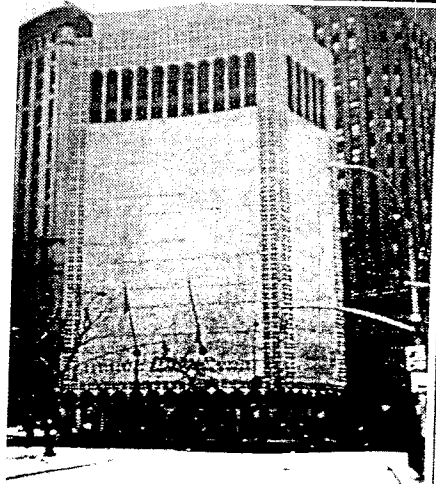

To save 2 Columbus Circle, call or write Mayor Giuliani 788-3000 or City Hall, NY, NY 10007. Don't demolish 2 Columbus Center. Use it as a museum.

The Historic Districts Council, the Municipal Art Society have asked the N.Y.C. Landmarks Preservation Commission to hold a public hearing in order to designate this major work by one of America's leading architects - Edward Durell Stone - as an individual landmark. It was built to house the Huntington Hartford Art collection.

Community groups, art connoisseurs, elected officials and residents of New York City favor use by such cultural institutions as the Dahesh Museum.

It would be exemplary if developers, who in this City are the leading force in land use policy, demonstrate their appreciation for culture and refrain from bidding on and destroying this architectural treasure.
