CURRENTS: WEB WATCHING; From a Blogger, Rants and Dish About the Architecture World

Now that Deep Throat has revealed himself, will the Guttersnipe come forth? The author of a Web log using that pseudonym has been ranting about the architecture world since May 9 at gutter.curbed.com. Favorite targets include architects of the project at the site of the World Trade Center, preservationists trying to save 2 Columbus Circle and The New York Times. Among the profanity-slinging writer's printable recent insults are "derivative yet anodyne," "a crashing bore" and "a complete boondoggle." The blogger seems to have some highly placed moles, alleging financial scandals and hinting at marital infidelities involving celebrities. But who knows so much, yet is willing to risk burning so many bridges? The site's publisher, Lockhart Steele, said it receives up to 4,000 hits a day. He would identify the Guttersnipe only as "an angry young man, raised in darkness." EVE M. KAHN
